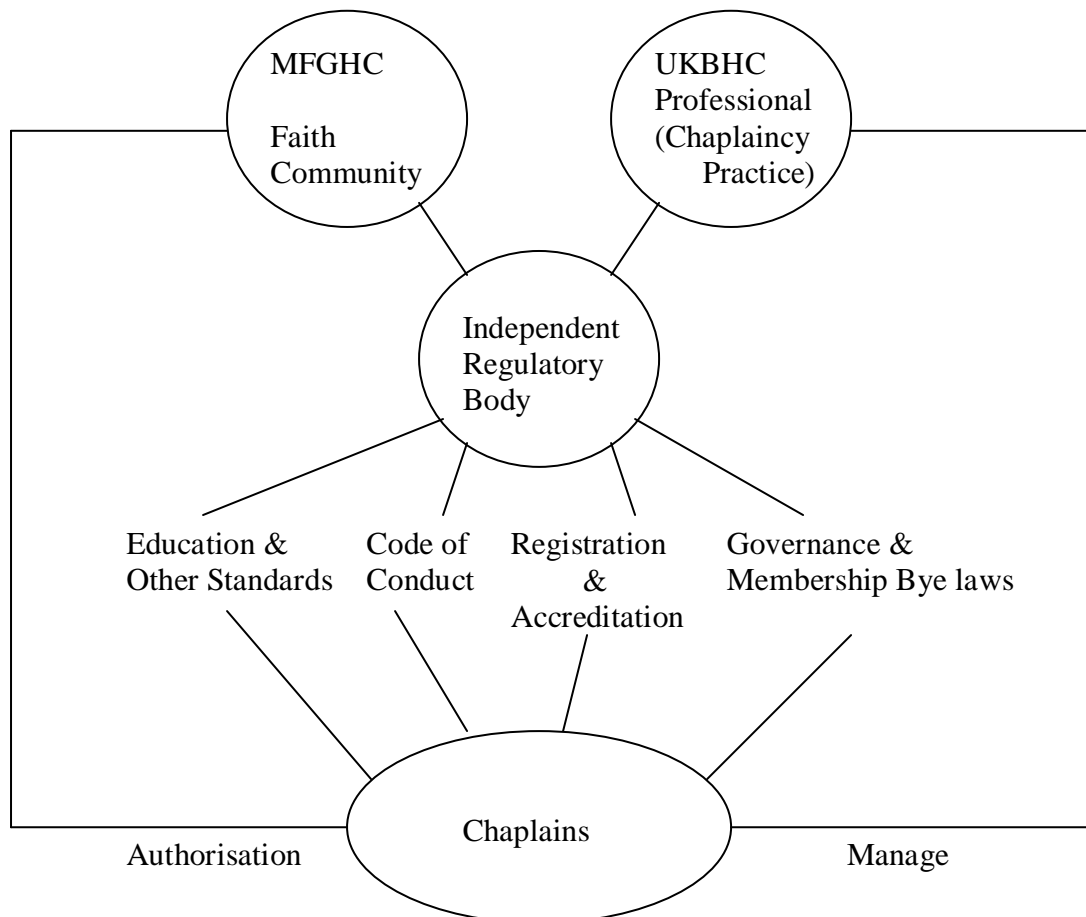


## Proposal from MFGHC to UKBHC for Joint working towards establishing Professional Chaplaincy

20<sup>th</sup> July 2010



The diagram is explained below:

MFGHC and UKBHC, along with some independent individuals and DoH/NHS/Trusts, work together to establish a Professional Regulatory body for Chaplaincy; similar to other existing regulatory bodies in health profession.

The working group submit their current developments in standards, education, CPD system etc to the regulatory body for adoption. The Regulatory body will generate Membership rules and Governance Bye laws to make it operational.

Any individual who wishes to join Chaplaincy will first obtain authorisation from his/her respective faith authorising body and apply for membership. Once registered with the Regulatory body the person can take on appointment as a chaplain and is managed by the Professional body.

The above proposal provides basis for further discussion and refinement.
